Task: Rewrite one of the stories from The Odyssey, told in the voice of one of the creatures Odysseus faced in his travels. You must choose a different section from the one your group produced in their radio broadcast.

Use the following checklist when writing your narrative:

Content

- Conflict showed from alternate perspective
- Traits of characters clear
- Narrative retells main plot events of story
- Setting is clearly described

Literary Elements to Include

- Dialogue
- Sensory Details
- At least two of the following
 - Metaphor
 - Similie
 - Personification
 - Alliteration
 - Hyperbole
- Vivid Verbs

Remember, just like Odysseus does, your narrative should place us directly in the action, while also showing us the conflict from a different perspective. Show your reader - do not simply tell them what is going on.
